

Pianist Nicholas Hrynyk is returning to his hometown to perform at Willard Chapel! The concert will include Nicholas' original compositions and never-released music, as well as works by Beethoven, Chopin, Debussy, and Ravel. Nicholas studied at the Eastman School of Music, Indiana University, and New York University, and has performed at Carnegie Hall, National Opera Center, Tenri Cultural Institute, Moulin d'Ande Cultural Center, Chautauqua Festival, and New York Fashion Week. This year's keynote speaker, Ms. Jessica James, wears many hats outside of her job and schooling. Born and raised in Buffalo, New York, Ms. Jessica James is a proud alumni of Buffalo Public Schools, P.S. 39 Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. - Multicultural Institute elementary school and Buffalo Academy for Visual & Performing Arts. After high school, Ms. James went on to college and graduated with two bachelor's degrees in Spanish Language & Literature from SUNY Buffalo and Criminal Justice from SUNY Brockport.

Today, Ms. James is employed at the Office of the NYS Attorney General in Syracuse, New York. Outside of her job and schooling, Ms. James is involved in Toastmasters International, where she continues to build her public speaking and leadership skills, involved in Autism Speaks as a seasoned Autism community self-advocate and serves on the NYS Autism Spectrum Disorders Advisory. She is also part of the current cohort of the Leadership Greater Syracuse program.

Ms. James also has earned many accolades, including the Toastmasters International Core Values Coin award, the 2014 Brockport Diversity Engagement Award, CSEA Partnership in Diversity, Equity, Inclusion Certificate of Completion, and three credentials from the International Board of Credentialing and Continuing Education Standards (IBCCES): the Autism Certificate, Student Mental Health Certificate, and Advanced Autism Certificate. Most recently, Ms. James earned her Human Rights Consultant certification through the US Institute of Diplomacy and Human Rights (USIDHR).
